2. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or my minor understand the nature of Table Tennis Activities and that I and/or my minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and/or my minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
3. FULLY UNDERSTAND that (a) TABLE TENNIS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or my child's own actions, or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.
4. HEREBY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE LOSSES, COSTS, AND/OR DAMAGES FOLLOWING SUCH INJURY, DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, OR DEATH, EVEN IF CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;
5. HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE USA TABLE TENNIS, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, officials, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON MY ACCOUNT CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE RESCUE OPERATIONS; AND I FURTHER AGREE that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT I and/or my minor child, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releases, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which may incur as the result of such claim.

I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT OR ASSURANCE OF ANY NATURE AND INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THE BALANCE, NOTWITHSTANDING, SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

Deadline: Entry deadline for the 2006 USA Table Tennis Nationals is Friday, November 3, 2006. Late entries postmarked after November 3 require a \$75 late fee. Entries postmarked after November 10, 2006 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Eligibility: Entries are limited to active USATT members as follows:

National Championship Events (Events 1-27):

- **U. S. citizens.** Proof of citizenship **must** be submitted with the entry form. "Mr. Neng-Chin Shih Memorial" Top 12 Junior and Cadet National Championship Events (Events 6-9)
- **U.S. citizens of the United States.** Proof of eligibility **must** be submitted with the entry form.
- Top 12 Cadet Boys'/Girls' Singles Events 6,7 – Born on or after January 1, 1992
- Top 12 Junior Boys'/Girls' Singles Events 8,9 – Born on or after January 1, 1989

National School Championship Events (Events 53-56)

- Residents of the United States
- Proof of age and School Enrollment must be Available at the Tournament
- 13&U Events - Born on or after January 1, 1993
- 10&U Events - Born on or after January 1, 1996

Championship Hard Bat and Rating Events (Events 28-52)

- Residents of the United States

**** For All Above Events Please contact USATT Headquarters (719-866-4583) regarding eligibility questions ****

Membership: USATT membership **must** be valid through December 2006. Non-members or those whose memberships have expired must enclose membership fees with their entry forms.

Rules: The 2006 USA Table Tennis Nationals will be conducted under the Laws of Table Tennis. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee will be final. Racquets complying with all requirements of the rules for Hard Bat racquets shall be legal.

Venue: Play will be held on two surfaces - red rubberized floor and concrete. **Display and/or distribution of any brochures, posters, literature, or written material at the tournament venue is strictly prohibited unless previously approved in writing by USA Table Tennis.**

Equipment: Butterfly tables and nets and Nittaku 3-star 40mm orange balls are the **Official Approved Equipment** for the 2006 USA Table Tennis National Championships.

Clothing: The USATT Dress Code will be enforced. Players **must** wear the assigned player numbers when competing.

Registration: Players must register with tournament officials at least 30 minutes before their first match and be ready to play each match 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time. See "Earliest Starting Times" in the *Schedule of Events*.

Entries: Players may enter a maximum of eight events **but may not enter two events starting at the same time.** PLAYERS MAY ENTER ANY NUMBER OF RATING EVENTS, NOT NECESSARILY IN SEQUENTIAL ORDER, FROM A MAXIMUM OF ANY 5 SEQUENTIAL EVENTS THAT ARE ABOVE HIS/HER RATING USED FOR THE 2006 USATT NATIONALS. FOR EXAMPLE, IF A PLAYER'S RATING IS 1346, HE/SHE MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE U-1800, U-1900, U-2000, U-2100, AND U-2200 EVENTS. HOWEVER, HE/SHE MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE U-1400, U-1500, AND U-1600 AND U-1900 AND U-2000 EVENTS SINCE THESE ARE NOT IN SEQUENTIAL ORDER. **Players may enter only one ratings doubles event. Players MUST be rated under 2500 to participate in the U-4200 Doubles; under 2250 to participate in the U-3700 Doubles; under 2000 to participate in the U-3200 Doubles; or under 1750 to participate in the U2700 Doubles.**

Matches: All matches at the 2006 USA Table Tennis Championships will utilize 11-point game rules with the exception of hard bat events (see hard bat info). Men's and women's championship events will be best of seven (11-point games) from the round of 32. All RR events will be the best of five (11-point games). All other events will be the best of five (11-point games), single elimination, unless otherwise indicated.

Event Scheduling: Events are not guaranteed to be completed on the same day that they begin. All events will be completed by Saturday evening. The Men's Singles semi-finals and final and Women's Singles final are tentatively scheduled for Saturday evening, December 16. **Any event may be cancelled and the entry fee for that one event refunded if the event contains less than four players or pairs, as appropriate.** In case of event conflicts, the player is responsible for notifying the Control Desk as soon as possible. In the case of an inadvertent error, liability is limited to the refund of the event fee for the event(s) involved.

Top 12 Junior (Girls only) and Cadet National Championship Events: The top finishers in these events will qualify as members of the 2007 USA Table Tennis Cadet and Junior (Girls Only) National Teams (respectively). Due to the conflict with the World Junior Championships, the Junior Boy's Team Trials will be held separately at a date TBD and announced. Participants in these events must be born on or after January 1, 1992 for cadet events, and on or after January 1, 1989 for junior events. **Cadet players may participate in Junior events.** The format for these events will be: Top 4 players according to the 10/01/2006 rating list will be qualified directly in the final round robin. All other players entered will play single elimination to the quarterfinals. **The quarterfinalists and the 4 players directly qualified** will be placed in 2 round robin groups of 6 players. After round robin there will be crossover matches and a final for each position. All matches will be the best of five. If a player should have a scheduled match in another event while playing in the team trials final round robin, it will be solely his/her responsibility to arrange his/her team trials matches so that he/she may play in the other event at its scheduled time. If such an arrangement cannot be made, then the player must forfeit their match in the other event. There will be no conflict resolution forms issued for these round robins.

Men's and Women's Singles Championship Events: First stage: round robin. Second stage: single elimination. Top 8 players in each event will be seeded in the final stage. If there are less than 32 players entered in the event then only top 4 players will be seeded in the final stage. All matches starting with the round of 32 will be played (11 points) best of seven games. All other matches will be played best of five.

Championship Age Events: Players must be over 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 75, and 80 as of December 31, 2006. Players in the 21&U Men's or Women's Singles must be born on or after January 1, 1985. Proof of age must be available at the tournament.

Hard Bat Events: Hard Bat rules, as adopted by the USATT Hard Bat Committee, will be used for all hard bat events. See www.hardbat.com for the complete list of official rules. As in all events, a question of racquet legality is the decision of the Tournament Referee. These events do not count for USATT ratings points. Eligibility for the hard bat rating events will be determined by the player's USATT rating. However, draws for the hard bat events will be conducted on the basis of the ratings maintained by the Hard Bat Committee. If a participant enters the U-2000 Hard Bat RR or U-1500 Hard Bat RR and there are insufficient entries, he/she will automatically be moved into the U-2000 RR or U-1500 RR, if eligible. All hard bat matches will be played to 21 points. All matches will be the best of 3 games, except for Hard Bat singles, where the quarterfinals, semifinals and final will be best of 5 games.

Doubles Partners: Players **MUST** enter with a partner in all doubles events. **USA Table Tennis will NOT be able to arrange for a doubles partner.**

Age Restrictions: Players assume the responsibility of entering the appropriate age events. Players who are over/under the age limit of an event will automatically be entered in the correct age event.

Rating Restrictions: A player's rating eligibility and seeding for the 2006 USA Table Tennis Nationals is based on his/her rating listed in the **2006 USATT Nationals Ratings List** generated October 1, 2006. This can be found at www.usatt.org/events/2006nationals/ratings. Players assume the responsibility of entering the proper events. Players that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered in the next higher rating event. Players may obtain their ratings by contacting USA Table Tennis via email at admin@usatt.org.

Unrated Players (players without a USATT rating): Unrated players may enter any championship event for which they are otherwise eligible. Unrated players will not advance in the rating-limited events, with the exception of the *Unrated RR*. Unrated players may not enter ratings doubles events.

Withdrawal: A \$30 processing fee will be charged to any participant who withdraws from the tournament prior to November 13, 2006. **There will be no refunds after this date.** Withdrawal notification must be received **in writing** at USATT Headquarters in order to receive a refund.

SPECIAL NOTE: *There will be no refunds given at the tournament.* A \$20 processing fee will be charged on all returned checks.

Films/Videotapes: Anyone wishing to make films or videotapes of the matches must receive written permission from USATT Headquarters. **Without regard to Approved Camera status, no videotaping of the Men's Semi-Finals, Women's Final, or Men's Final matches is allowed.**

Likeness Release: Any image, photographic or otherwise, taken of tournament play or within the official venue is essentially the property of USA Table Tennis regardless of the Approved Camera status of the recording instrument. Entrants agree to allow their voice and likeness in such images to be reproduced in connection with USA Table Tennis by way of any medium.

Umpires: **If an umpire is available,** a certified umpire will be assigned by the chief umpire at the request of any player in a match.

Confirmation of Entries: Confirmation of receipt of entry will be placed online at the USATT website in the U.S. Nationals section. Names will be posted within 14 days after receiving your entry. USATT will not be responsible for entries lost in the mail.
