3. Players may enter a maximum of 5 rating events. Events chosen must be within the 5 sequential order that are above his/her rating used for the 2009 U. S. Open. For example, if a player's rating is 1346, he/she may participate in the U-1350, U-1450, U-1600, and U-1900 events. He/she may NOT also participate in the U-2050 and above events. Players may NOT participate in both Men's Over 40 Singles and Hard Bat Over 40 Singles; U-2050 RR and U-2000 Hard Bat RR; or U-1450 RR and U-1500 Hard Bat RR. He/She must choose between the two events. Events may be combined if entries were insufficient.

Players **MUST** be rated under 2500 to participate in the U 4200 Doubles, under 2250 to participate in the U3700 Doubles, or under 2000 to participate in the U3200 Doubles.

Age events: **9 and Under**- must be born on or after 01/01/2000; **11 and Under**- must be born on or after 01/01/1998; **13 and under** - must be born on or after 01/01/1996; **Cadet Events**- must be born on or after 01/01/1994. **Junior events**- must be born on or after 01/01/1991. Eligibility:

The 2009 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships is open to all members of USATT and to members of ITTF-affiliated associations. USATT membership MUST be valid through July 2009. USA residents who are non-members or those with memberships that have expired must enclose membership fees with their entry forms.

Rules:

The 2009 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships will be conducted under the Laws of Table Tennis and the ITTF Regulations for International Competitions, except for hard bat events (see below). All decisions made by the Tournament Committee will be final and contestants upon entering, agree to abide by them.

Floor:

Play will be held on two surfaces - red rubberized floor and concrete.

Equipment:

The official table supplier is Butterfly. Orange Nittaku three star balls are the Official Approved balls for the 2009 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships.

Registration:

Players must check-in with the tournament officials at least 30 minutes before their first match and be ready to play each match 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time.

Entries:

Players may enter a maximum of eight events, but may not enter two events starting at the same time. All matches, both singles and doubles, will be scheduled in advance in each event. Players will receive notification when they register.

Publications: Display and/or distribution of any brochures, posters, literature, or written material at the tournament venue is strictly prohibited unless previously approved in writing by USA Table Tennis

RATING EVENTS

1. Players may enter a maximum of 5 rating events. Events chosen must be within the 5 sequential order that are above his/her rating used for the 2009 U.S. Open. For example, if a player's rating is 1346, he/she may participate in any or all of the following: U1350, U1450, U1600, U1750, and U1900, but not U1350, U1450, U1750, U1900, and U2050; because the player skipped U1600 and added U2050.
2. Players that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered in the next higher rating event.

RATING DOUBLES EVENTS

1. Players may enter only one rating doubles event.
2. Players MUST be rated under 2500 to participate in the U4200 Doubles, under 2250 to participate in the U3700 Doubles, and under 2000 to participate in the U3200 Doubles.
3. Each person must enter with a doubles partner. USA Table Tennis will NOT be able to arrange for doubles partners.

Event Scheduling:

Events are not guaranteed to complete on the same day that they begin. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR EARLY DEPARTURE. Any event may be cancelled and the entry fee for that event refunded if the event contains less than four players, pairs or teams as appropriate. In case of event conflicts, the player is responsible for notifying the Control Desk as soon as possible. In the case of an inadvertent error, liability is limited to the refund of the event fee for the event(s) involved.

Championship Age Events:

+Age events: 9 and Under - must be born on or after 01/01/2000; 11 and Under - must be born on or after 01/01/1998; 13 and Under - must be born on or after 01/01/1996; Cadet Events - must be born on or after 01/01/1994; Junior Events - must be born on or after 01/01/1991. Under 21 - must be born on or after 01/01/1988. Players must be at least 30, 40, 50, 60, 65, 70, 75, or 80 as of December 31, 2009 to enter the corresponding events: Over 30, Over 40, Over 50, Over 60, Over 65, Over 70, Over 75, and Over 80 events.

HARD BAT EVENTS

1. Hard Bat Rules, as adopted by the USATT Hard Bat Committee, will be used for all hard bat events: a) short pips, no sponge, b) wood bats only, c) any color rubber is acceptable, d) no foot-stomping during service, and e) hats, long pants, long sleeves, etc. are acceptable. See www.hardbat.com for the complete list of official rules.
2. As in all events, a question of racket legality is the decision of the Tournament Referee.
3. These events do not count for USATT rating points.
4. Eligibility for the hard bat rating events will be determined by the player's USATT rating. However, draws for the hardbat events will be conducted on the basis of the ratings maintained by the Hard Bat Committee.
5. Players may NOT participate in both the U2050 RR and U2000 Hard Bat RR or both the U1450 RR and the U1500 Hard Bat RR. He/She must select which events he/she wishes to play.
6. If a participant enters the U2000 Hard Bat RR or U1500 Hard Bat RR and there are insufficient entries, he/she will automatically be moved into the next lowest non-hard bat rating event according to the player's rating.
7. All Hard Bat matches will be played to 21 points. All matches will be the best of 3 games, with the exception of the Hard Bat Singles. For the quarterfinals, semifinals, and finals, the Hard Bat singles will be the best of 5 games to 21 points.

Playing Format:

Men's and Women's Singles:

In men's singles the top 16 players will be seeded into the main draw of 64 players. In women's singles the top 8 players will be seeded into the main draw of 32 players. Depending on the number of entries, all other players will be drawn into qualification RR groups to advance into the main draw. The main draw will be played in a single elimination format. All matches will be played best of 7 games. Semis and Finals will start at 5 P.M. on Saturday, July 4.

Men's/Women's Doubles:

8 pairs will be seeded into the main draw in these events. The rest of the teams will play qualification matches in a single elimination format. The main draw will consist of 16 doubles pairs and will be played in a single elimination format. Matches in qualification rounds will be played best of 5 games, and in the main draw best of 7 games.

U21 Men's/U21 Women's Singles:

Born on or after January 1, 1988. Top 8 players will be seeded into the main draw in these events. Depending on the number of entries, all other players will be drawn into qualification RR groups to advance into the main draw. The main draw will be played in a single elimination format. For U21 Men's Singles, the main draw will consist of 32 players, and for U21 Women's Singles, the main draw will consist of 16 players. Matches in qualification rounds will be played best of 5 games, and in the main draw best of 7 games.

Events 07 - 57

Events 07 - 57 will be best of 5 games to 11 points with the exception of hard bat events (see above)

Doubles Partners:

Players MUST enter with a partner in all doubles events. USA TABLE TENNIS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ARRANGE FOR DOUBLES PARTNERS

Age Restrictions:

Players assume the responsibility of entering the appropriate age events. Players who are over/under the age limit of an event will be automatically entered in the correct age event.

Rating Restrictions & Seeding:

A player's rating eligibility for the 2009 U.S. Open are based on his/her rating as shown on the ratings list generated May 1, 2009. Players assume the responsibility of entering the proper events. Players that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered in the next higher event. Players may obtain their ratings by emailing ratings@notabletennis.com. For draw and seeding purposes the most recent ITTF world ranking and USATT ratings list generated June 5, 2009 will be used. As a result of later seeding, some players may have ratings higher than shown for the event.

U.S. Unrated Players (players without a USATT rating):

Unrated U.S. Players may enter any Championship event for which they are otherwise eligible. Unrated players will not advance in rating-limited events. Unrated players may not enter rating doubles events. The Tournament Director will be the final authority on a player's rating status.

Films/Videotapes:

Anyone wishing to make films or videotapes of their own matches or any other matches must receive written permission from USATT, 1 Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909.

Deadline:

Entries for the 2009 US Open Table Tennis Championships must be postmarked no later than Thursday, May 21, 2009. Entries postmarked after May 29, 2009 **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**

Withdrawal:

A \$35 processing fee will be charged to any participant who withdraws IN WRITING from the tournament prior to June 1, 2009. **There will be no refunds after this date. There will be no refunds given at the tournament.**

Cancellation Without Fault:

USATT will refund 50% of all entry fees paid by participants if the U.S. Open event is cancelled or partially cancelled due to acts of God, force majeure, war within the continental U.S., governmental authority, disaster, strikes, civil disorder, curtailment of transportation services that prevent at least 50% or more of USATT participants from attending the event.

Umpires:

If an umpire is available, a certified umpire will be assigned by the Chief Umpire at the request of any player in a match.

Additional Information & Rules:

1. No changes in doubles partners, addition or deletion of events, or refunds of event fees will be allowed after the final deadline or at the tournament site.
2. USA Table Tennis cannot be responsible for the non-participation of selected doubles partner(s). No refunds will be given for an event if a partner is not available.
3. Prize money checks which are not claimed at the tournament site will be mailed to the winner within one month of the conclusion of the tournament.
4. Trophies and award certificates not claimed at the tournament site WILL NOT be shipped.
5. A Social Security Number, or Pertinent Passport Information are required upon receipt of prize money check.
