1. IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in USA Table Tennis sanctioned events, I and/or minor child, our personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:
2. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or my minor understand the nature of Table Tennis Activities and that I and/or minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and/or minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
3. FULLY UNDERSTAND that (a) TABLE TENNIS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH, HARASSMENT, EXPOSURE TO INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT AND LANGUAGE ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or child's own actions, or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SEVERE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE USA TABLE TENNIS, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, officials, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON MY ACCOUNT CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS; AND I FURTHER AGREE that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT I and/or my minor child, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releases, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE, AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which may incur as the result of such claim.

Deadline:

Entries for the 2010 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships must be postmarked no later than Thursday, May 13, 2010. Entries postmarked after May 13 will be accepted with a \$75 late fee. Entries postmarked after May 21, 2010 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Eligibility:

The 2010 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships is open to all members of USATT and to members of ITTF-affiliated associations. USATT membership MUST be valid through July, 2010. USA residents who are non-members or those with memberships that have expired must enclose membership fees with their entry forms.

Rules:

The 2010 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships will be conducted under the ITTF Laws and Rules of Table Tennis and Regulations for International Competitions, except for Hard Bat events (see below). Specifically Chapter 3 of the ITTF Handbook Section 3.5.3, 3.5.3.1, and 3.5.3.2. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee will be final and contestants upon entering, agree to abide by them.

Equipment:

Tables and nets: Butterfly. Balls: Nittaku orange 3-star 40mm. Floor: Two surfaces – red rubberized floor and concrete. This is the Official Approved Equipment for the 2010 U.S. Open Table Tennis Championships. **"Rackets in all events are subject to random testing for volatile organic compounds (VOC's). Any glues containing VOC's will cause the racket to fail."** It is recommended that each player come to the table with 2 legal rackets and 2 distinctively different colored shirts that are different from the color of the ball.

Entries:

Players may enter a maximum of **eight events**, but may not enter two events starting at the same time. All matches, both singles and doubles, will be scheduled in advance in each event. Players will receive notification when they register.

RATING EVENTS

1. Players may enter a maximum of 5 rating events. Events chosen must be within the 5 sequential order that are above his/her rating used for the 2010 U.S. Open. For example, if a player's rating is 1346, he/she may participate in any or all of the following: U1350, U1500, U1650, U1800, and U1950, but not U1350, U1500, U1800, U1950, and U2100, because the player skipped U1650 and added U2100.
2. Players that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered in the next higher rating event.

RATING DOUBLES EVENTS:

1. Players may enter only one rating doubles event.
2. Players MUST be rated under 2500 to participate in the U4200 Doubles, under 2250 to participate in the U3700 Doubles, and under 2000 to participate in U3200 Doubles.

Doubles Partners:

Players **MUST** enter with a partner in all doubles events. **USA Table Tennis will NOT arrange for a doubles partner.** USATT can not be responsible for the non-participation of your selected Doubles Partner. It is the responsibility of the players to contact his/her doubles partner about participating in the event. No refunds will be given for an event if a partner is not available. **Special Note:** No change in doubles partners, addition or deletion of events or refund of event fees will be allowed after the final deadline or at the tournament.

Age Restrictions:

Players assume the responsibility of entering the appropriate age events. Players who are over/under the age limit of an event will be automatically entered in the correct age event.

Rating Restrictions & Seeding:

A player's rating eligibility for the 2010 U.S. Open are based on his/her rating as shown on the ratings list generated 4/30/2010 - http://www.usatt.org/events/2010_usopen/ratings.html. Players assume the responsibility of entering the proper events. Players that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered into the next higher event. Players may obtain their ratings by emailing ratings@usatt.org. For draw and seeding purposes the most recent ITTF World Ranking and USATT ratings list generated June 4, 2010 will be used. As a result of later seeding, some players may have ratings higher than shown for the event.

U.S. Unrated Players (players without a USATT rating):

Unrated U.S. players may enter any Championship event for which they are otherwise eligible. Unrated players will not advance in rating-limited events. Unrated players may not enter rating doubles events. The Tournament Director will be the final authority on a player's rating status.

Event Scheduling:

Events are not guaranteed to complete on the same day that they begin. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR EARLY DEPARTURE. Any event may be cancelled and the entry fee for that event refunded if the event contains fewer than four players, pairs, or teams as appropriate. In case of event conflicts, the player is responsible for notifying the Control Desk as soon as possible. In the case of an inadvertent error, liability is limited to the refund of the event fee for the event(s) involved.

Championship Age Events:

Age: **9 and Under** – must be born on or after 01/01/2001; **11 and Under** – must be born on or after 01/01/1999; **13 and Under** – must be born on or after 01/01/1997;

Cadet Events – must be born on or after 01/01/1995; **Junior Events** – must be born on or after 01/01/1992; **Under 21** – must be born on or after 01/01/1989; **Players** must be on at least **30, 40, 50, 60, 65, 70, 75 or 80** as of December 31, 2010 to enter the corresponding events: Over 30, Over 40, Over 50, Over 60, Over 65, Over 70, Over 75, and Over 80 events. Proof of age must be readily available at tournament.

Withdrawal:

A \$35 processing fee will be charged to any participant who withdraws IN WRITING from the tournament prior to May 31, 2010. **There will be no refunds after this date. There will be no refunds given at the tournament.**

Playing Format:

Men's and Women's Singles:

In men's singles, the top 16 players will be seeded into the main draw of 64 players. In the women's singles, the top 8 players will be seeded into the main draw of 32 players. Depending on the number of entries, all other players will be drawn into qualification RR groups to advance into the main draw. The main draw will be played in a single elimination format. All matches will be played best of 7 games. Semis and Finals will start at 5:00PM on Saturday, July 3.

Men's and Women's Doubles:

8 pairs will be seeded into the main draw in these events. The rest of the teams will play qualification matches in a single elimination format. The main draw will consist of 16

doubles pairs and will be played in a singles elimination format. Matches in qualification rounds will be played best of 5 games and in the main draw best of 7 games.

U21 Men's and Women's Singles:

Born on or after January 1, 1989. Top 8 players will be seeded into the main draw in these events. Depending on the number of entries, all other players will be drawn into qualification RR groups to advance into the main draw. The main draw will be played in a single elimination format. For U21 Men's Singles, the main draw will consist of 32 players, and for U21 Women's Singles, the main draw will consist of 16 players. Matches in qualification rounds will be played best of 5 games, and in the main draw best of 7 games.

Junior Boys and Girls Teams:

The USA Club or Foreign Association must send an email to admin@usatt.org with Club Name or Association along with Names of Team Players. The Junior Team will not be accepted without Club or Association approval. The Club or Association along with the Names of the Team Mates must be listed on the entry form. Playing system: Corbillon Cup System: 4 singles and 1 doubles. A-X, B-Y, Doubles, A-Y, B-X. The team shall consist of 2,3, or 4 players.

LIHA Sandpaper:

The same rules as Hardbat (see below) will apply except the equipment shall be an all-wood blade with a sandpaper only cover of the playing surface and 38mm balls. **Events 07 – 61** will be best of 5 games to 11 points with the exception of hard bat events. Hard Bat matches will be played to 21 points.

Hardbat Events:

Hard Bat Rules, as adopted by the USATT Hard Bat Committee, will be used for all hard bat events. See www.hardbat.com for the complete list of official rules. These events do not count for USATT rating points. Eligibility for the hard bat rating events will be determined by the player's USATT rating. However, draws for the hard bat events will be conducted on the basis of the ratings maintained by the Hard Bat Committee. If a participant enters the U2000 Hard Bat RR or U1500 Hard Bat RR and there are insufficient entries, he/she will automatically be moved into the next lowest non-hard bat rating event according to the player's rating. All matches will be the best of 3 games with the exception of the Hard Bat Singles. For the quarterfinals, semifinals, and finals, the Hard Bat singles will be the best of 5 games.

Registration:

Players must check-in with the tournament officials at least 30 minutes before their first match and be ready to play each match 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time. The Registration Desk will be open on Tuesday – 12:00 to 8:00PM, Wednesday, Thursday, & Friday – 8:00AM to 8:00PM and Saturday – 8:00AM to 5:00PM.
